BASKETBALL (Girls)

Kindly ensure that the following details are submitted at the registration counter on

Friday, 21st August 2026

- ✓ Students ID / Admit Card form (with unique ID and photo) signed by the school Principal. (Downloaded by logging into <http://cbseports.in/>).
- ✓ List of Participants from the School signed by the principal. (Downloaded by logging into <http://cbseports.in/>).
- ✓ Proof for date of birth (Birth Certificate / Bonafide from School) and original Aadhar Card for each child.
- ✓ Scanned copy of fee receipt of Annual Sports fee of Rs. 10,000/- paid to CBSE for 2025-26.
- ✓ All the participating schools will have to deposit the security amount of **Rs. 2000/-** (Refundable) to the registration counter at the time of registration.
- ✓ Group photograph of the team with the Principal's signature and seal.
- ✓ School flag for opening and closing ceremonies.
- ✓ Copy of the online registration duly attested by the Principal of the School.
- ✓ Individual Unique ID card of the participants downloaded from CBSE website and attested with Principal's signature and seal.
- ✓ Student / Player studying in grade X & XII must provide CBSE registration number.



RULES & REGULATIONS

- ✓ Team Managers/Coaches must carry all original documents verifying the players' age and their status as bonafide students, as per CBSE norms.
- ✓ Failure to produce original documents at the time of reporting will lead to forfeiture of the player's right to participate.
- ✓ All the participants must carry their valid age proof certificate and CBSE Board Identity – card.
- ✓ The tournament will be conducted according to the rules of Basketball Federation of India with modifications wherever applicable. (Strictly amendment made as per CBSE)
- ✓ The number of players representing a school shall not be more than twelve and not less than 10. A coach may substitute for the other players (11th and 12th player) provided that each of the earlier 10 players has played in one full quarter.
- ✓ If a school decides to withdraw from the tournament, they must inform the organizing school via email. School withdrawing from the tournament without informing the organizing school shall be penalized Rs. 1000/- as per CBSE Games guidelines.
- ✓ All the matches at Cluster level shall be conducted on knock out basis. In case the number of teams is less, the Cluster level tournament may be organized on league basis.
- ✓ In any match, played on knock out basis including the final, if there is a tie, extension of five minutes shall continue to be given till the game is decided.
- ✓ 6" size ball will be used for all matches.
- ✓ A team should be prepared to play more than two matches in a day.
- ✓ All participating teams shall carry with them two sets of playing kit (uniform), one set of light colour and the other set of dark colour.
- ✓ The team that has been named first in the fixture will sit on the left side of the Official's Table, and shall score towards the right side of the court.
- ✓ Protest, if any, must be submitted in writing along with the fee fixed by CBSE (Rs. 1000/-) within 30 min after the declaration of the result.
- ✓ In case a team intends to protest against the opposite team; the captain of team that intends to protest, must sign the score sheet.
- ✓ In case a team forfeits & walks out of the court without completing the match, it shall lose the right to submit any protest and shall be debarred from the rest of the tournament.



ACCREDITED REPRESENTATIVES (TEACHER / COACH / MANAGER)

- ✓ All the teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher / Coach / Manager designated by the participating school Principal.
- ✓ No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.
- ✓ No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However, if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letterhead.
- ✓ No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
- ✓ The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school Principal.
- ✓ No extra person shall be permitted to stay on the school premises and on the play field along with the teams.

GENERAL / MANDATORY INSTRUCTIONS

- ✓ Taking part in the Opening ceremony, March Past is mandatory for all schools.
- ✓ Escort Coach / Manager shall be held responsible for their student's behaviour and use of abusive language. The same shall be reported to their school Principal / Management.
- ✓ At the time of game in progress only participating or qualified students / athletes shall be entitled to enter the basketball court, other players should stay out of basketball court.
- ✓ Players must give their attendance to the reporting official 30 min prior to the scheduled time of game.
- ✓ It is mandatory for all coaches / managers / players to wear the school Identity Card during the days of the tournament irrespective of being on or out of the school campus.
- ✓ It is mandatory for all the schools to deposit the required amount for all the days of competition as per CBSE norms at the time of reporting.
- ✓ Students' movement after 08:00 p.m. outside their accommodation room / campus is not allowed. Coach Manager is responsible for any mishappening. Nobody shall be allowed to leave campus without prior notice and authorization from the Organizing Principal or Organizing Secretary.
- ✓ It is mandatory for all Coaches & Managers to stay with students in the allotted accommodation rooms.
- ✓ Carrying and using tobacco and liquor is strictly prohibited on the school campus / accommodation area. If any coach /manager / student is found drunk or smoking on the school campus / accommodation area, his / her team shall be disqualified with immediate effect and the same will be informed to their Principal. Other serious consequences may also follow.
- ✓ Vegetarian and Eggetarian meals will be served in the campus. Outside food is not allowed.
- ✓ Avail the breakfast, lunch / dinner as per the timings without any delay.



- ✓ The host school shall not be responsible for any incident that may happen outside of the school campus during outing of any coach / manager / team or players.
- ✓ Teams should use the washrooms allotted to them.
- ✓ Kindly do not touch the materials which are costly and sensitive:
 - Smart Boards
 - CCTV Camera
 - Window glass
 - Fans, Lights, Cupboards, etc.
 - Flat Panels
- In case any item is found damaged, the cost of repair/replacement will have to be borne by the team concerned.
- ✓ Playing inside the accommodation room is strictly prohibited.
- ✓ Maintaining hygiene is a collective responsibility. Kindly ensure that the toilets are kept clean and taps/flush are properly closed after use.
- ✓ Don't clog bathrooms & toilets. Use dustbin to discard sanitary items, paper, wrappers, etc.
- ✓ Drinking water: Each floor has a RO water cooler. Please do not squander water.
- ✓ A movement register will be maintained for coaches, managers, and participants.
- ✓ Coaches, managers, and participants need to enter the details in the register kept with the security staff at the school's main gate. All members are requested to use gate # 4 for the movement. No one is allowed to use any other gate to move in and out of the campus.
- ✓ Use a dustbin for all waste materials, including disposable bags, paper plates, and cups.
